Major Waldron's is located on Route 9 just 1.2 miles east of the intersection of Routes 9 and 125 (GPS 26 Franklin Pierce Hwy). The facilities include: covered outdoor ranges for up to 50-yard pistol; 100/200/300-yard rifle; an Indoor range for up to 25-yard pistol and .22 cal. rim fire rifle with 10 firing points; two Trap and Skeet fields (one field with Modern Skeet); and a large Clubhouse facility.

The Outdoor Range is available to Qualified Members only, unless a scheduled event is being held on that day. Members must attend an orientation session to become qualified, which is usually held on the Saturday following the monthly meeting. The qualification is active as long as the person's membership is kept current.

The Indoor Range is available to Qualified Members only, unless a scheduled event, on a pay per use basis. Members must qualify for unescorted access to the indoor range by showing proficiency in their ability to shoot. The access is renewed annually with the rental of an access key. The member must also be a member of the Association for one year before completing qualification for unescorted access.

Trap and Skeet are available to members and non-members on a fee-per-round basis. The fee for the Association member is reduced from that of non-members.

The Association holds NRA Certified Classes in Personal Protection, Rifle, Pistol, and Shotgun at various times throughout the year.

NH Hunter Safety Courses are offered in the spring and fall. The Association sponsors a monthly 4-H Shooting Program for youths age 8 to 18 which includes instruction in firearms safety as well as rifle, pistol, shotgun, and archery training.

Competition at the Association includes; a winter small bore rifle league, indoor pistol league; and tactical pistol shooting.

New Member Instructions

1. Fill out the attached Membership Application form. Sign and date the form.
2. Send the completed Membership Application with payment to the address listed on the application.
3. Student members joining through the UNH Shooting Club need not send payment as it is part of the sport club dues.
4. Junior Members must be accompanied by a qualified adult member of MWSA when using the ranges.
5. The Board of Directors will act on the application at the next director's meeting following receipt of the properly completed application no later than the Friday prior to the meeting date to be considered at the next meeting of the directors.
6. If the application is accepted, the Board of Directors will notify the applicant by mail to attend the next General Membership Meeting where the application will be brought before the entire membership for consideration. The General Membership Meeting is the third Monday of each month at 7:00 PM, except June, or as otherwise decided by the Board of Directors. Any applicant who is rejected for membership by the Association will have their money refunded within two weeks of the rejection of their application.
7. All new membership applicants are required to attend a New Member Safety and Orientation session to become familiar with the Safety Rules and the facility. The acceptance letter will inform the applicant of the place and time of the session. All family members that intend to use the facility are required to also attend the session. The phone number of the Safety Committee Chairman will be on the acceptance letter. If you are unable to attend the New Member Safety and Orientation Session as scheduled, the Safety Chairman should be notified to set up alternate arrangements. The Safety and Orientation Session must be completed for the applicant to receive the membership packet and be allowed to use the Association's ranges.
8. New member applicants of the UNH Shooting Club who have attended the orientation / safety class are not required to attend another session. UNH Shooting Club Applicants of the spring of 2002 have been accepted for membership conditioned on completion of this application and receipt by MWSA of the required fees from UNH. If you are a UNH Shooting Club Member do not send payment with this application.
