



MAJOR WALDRON SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I hereby expressly assume any and all risks associated with shooting on the properties of the Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association, Barrington, NH. I know shooting is considered by many to be dangerous, and I hereby assume the risk of any and all injuries I may suffer due to the physical condition of Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association, the acts or omissions of other shooters who may be on or near Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association, whether with or without permission, equipment failure, acts of God and/or any other reason.

I have been advised that there will be other persons shooting and carrying firearms on Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association and I agree to act prudently and carefully to avoid causing them injury. I certify that I am familiar with the use and operation of the firearm(s) I will be using while on Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association and that I am familiar with the rules of shooting and firearms safety.

I release Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association, together with all club members, directors, agents, and representatives for any and all claims for personal injury, wrongful death, and/or property damage which may arise in my favor and which may occur during or as a result of my presence on Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association as referenced above regardless of the cause of any such injury and including those which may be caused by negligence and/or any other cause.

I give this release and assume all risks attendant thereto consideration of being allowed to enter into and shoot at Major Waldron Sportsmen's Association.

The release and assumption of risk will be binding on my heirs, executors and assigns.

PARENT/GUARDIAN

1. All members will be required to sign in before using the range
2. All guests will be required to sign a hold harmless agreement before using the range
3. Members may bring a guest or another member who has not qualified with the following conditions:
 - You will be responsible for that person's actions
 - You will be required to make them aware of the range rules
 - You must not be shooting while the guest/other member is shooting
4. The gate must be left open while you are on the range
5. The gate must be locked if you are the last person to leave the range.
6. Members must qualify to use the range without supervision. If they observe anyone not following safety/range rules, the Outdoor Range Chairman must be notified without delay via telephone, email or written message placed in the lockbox.
7. All Range Officer commands will be followed! A Cease Fire may be called at any time by anyone without warning in a safety or emergency situation. During a Cease Fire, the Cease Fire flag or range lights must be displayed.
8. When the range is hot, eye and ear protection must be worn at all times.
9. Membership badges must be visible at all times and presented upon request.
10. All firearms must be holstered, cased, or actions open/made safe while entering and leaving the range property.
11. No shooting will be permitted while members are down range on the *Rifle* (long side). Members are permitted to go down range on the *Pistol* (short side) while firing is being conducted on the *Rifle* (long side).
12. When shooters are downrange, NO handling of firearms will be permitted. They are to be laid on the shooting table or ground, stored in the gun racks or cased with the actions open and safe.
13. The Three Basic Rules of Firearm's Handling MUST be followed at all times:
 - point all firearms in a safe direction
 - keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire
 - keep your firearm unloaded until ready to fire
14. All bullets must impact the berm to prevent ricochets. Adjust all targets so the bullets will strike the berm area.
15. Only target stands provided by MWSA will be allowed except during special events approved by the Board of Directors. No cross target shooting is allowed.
16. Targets must be cardboard or paper only except during special events approved by the Board of Directors.
17. Targets must be removed at the completion of the shooting session.
18. Address all safety concerns immediately.
19. All minors must be accompanied and supervised by an adult member.
20. Uncontrolled or unsafe behavior will result in the revocation of shooting privileges.
21. Range use fee (\$5.00 non-members) must be placed in the lockbox.
22. You may be told to leave the Outdoor Range by a Range Officer for repeated unsafe or dangerous practices. You will be required to attend a *Board of Directors* Meeting to regain your privileges.
23. No full or automatic firing will be permitted.
24. No tracer, incendiary, armor piercing, explosive or illegal ammunition is permitted to be used on the outdoor range.
25. No alcohol or illegal drugs are allowed on any property owned or controlled by MWSA.
26. No eating, drinking or smoking is allowed on the firing line.
27. All spent brass must be removed from the firing line. All steel brass must be placed in the garbage cans provided.
28. Shooting will be permitted from 0900 until one half hour prior to the published sunset. Sunset times are posted in the Sign-In book.
29. The outdoor ranges are closed **Christmas Day** and **Easter**.
