NRA and OTHER COURSES

TACTICAL PRACTICE / SURVIVOR SERIES the fourth Friday and Sunday of the month, *but check the calendar in case there are changes*. Friday classes start at 6:30 PM are open to anyone who has been to previous Sunday TPs. Sunday classes are split, with experienced shooters 8-10 AM, new shooters 10 AM until Noon or 1:00 PM. These monthly sessions are meant to develop, maintain and test a shooter's defensive tactics and skills. Topics include mental attitude, low light shooting, concealed carry, cover and concealment, weak-hand shooting and firearms handling, selection of the optimum firearms/calibers for individual use and many other topics.

 - Targets at 25, 50, 100, 200 and 300 yards
