## NRA and OTHER COURSES

**TACTICAL PISTOL PRACTICE** the fourth Friday of September and October, *but check the calendar in case there are changes.* There will be no Sunday TPs during these two months. Classes start at 6:30 PM are open to anyone who has been to previous Sunday TPs. These monthly sessions are meant to develop, maintain and test a shooter's defensive tactics and skills. Topics include mental attitude, low light shooting, concealed carry, cover and concealment, weak-hand shooting and firearms handling, selection of the optimum firearms/calibers for individual use and many other topics.

**HUNTER SAFETY EDUCATION** September 2, 4, 8, 10, 11, 16, 18, 19, and 20. The Hunter Education course is required by all states prior to obtaining your first hunting license.
